

Alabama State University (ASU) began in 1867 as Lincoln Normal School, a private school for Negroes located in Marion, Alabama. In 1878, William Burns Paterson was name President. President Paterson referred as the “founder” of Alabama State University. Today, ASU has ten major units: University College, College of Liberal Arts & Social Science, College of Science, Mathematics & Technology, College of Health Sciences, College of Business Administration, College of Education, the College of Visual and Performing Arts, the School of Graduate Studies, Continuing Education and the Division of Aerospace Studies. The academic offerings range from the baccalaureate to the doctorate degree. The faculty has grown from three to over 400. The university has conferred 100 associate degrees, 35,638 baccalaureate degrees and 11,694 graduate degrees through summer 2018. Dr. Leon C. Wilson serving as interim president, having begun his tenure February 2014 and Dr. Quinton T. Ross Jr. serving as president, having begun his tenure September 2017
