
MEASURE 3: Demonstrate Student Achievement Measures through Graduation from Academic Programs

Identification: The successful completion of academic programs leading to degree certification serves as the most direct indicator of an institution's attainment of its educational measures. Figure 3 presents the six-year cohort graduation rates for first-time, full-time undergraduate students over the most recent five years, specifically from Fall 2013 to Fall 2017.

Evaluation: Over the past five years, the cohort graduation rate experienced a decline, but in the past year, from 2016 to 2017, there was an increase of 2%.
